Notes:

- Surveys in March 2018 (primarily by car for safety reasons) may have overlooked protected or invasive flora, or other protected species (if present) due to seasonality and/or because private lands could not be surveyed.
- No Annex 1 habitats were recorded.
- There is potential for nesting birds in any vegetated areas, wetlands or built structures.
- A suitably experienced ecologist should be consulted to advise on licensing and mitigation requirements should any trees or structures with suitability for roosting bats be proposed for direct disturbance, or indirect disturbance (e.g. by lighting).
- 'Offline' (greenfield) areas on private lands were not surveyed and should be assessed by a suitably qualified ecologist in the appropriate season as part of ecological inputs to planning
